Main Passage

Three Prayers of Thanksgiving to Pray Today

Prayer #1 – Lord...Thank You for Your Perfect Provision of Protection and Power

Prayer #2 – Lord...Thank You for Your Perfect Provision of Perseverance

Psalm 46:4-7 (ESV) – ⁴ There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy habitation of the Most High. ⁵ God is in the midst of her; she shall not be moved; God will help her when morning dawns. ⁶ The nations rage, the kingdoms totter; he utters his voice, the earth melts. ⁷ The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress. *Selah*

Prayer #3 – Lord...Thank You for Your Majesty for You Are Worthy to Be Praised as the Preeminent Provider

Psalm 46:8-11 (ESV) – ⁸ Come, behold the works of the LORD, how he has brought desolations on the earth. ⁹ He makes wars cease to the end of the earth; he breaks the bow and shatters the spear; he burns the chariots with fire. ¹⁰ "Be still, and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!" ¹¹ The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress. *Selah*
