Main Text

Psalm 150:1-6 (ESV) – ¹Praise the LORD! Praise God in his sanctuary; praise him in his mighty heavens! ²Praise him for his mighty deeds; praise him according to his excellent greatness! ³Praise him with trumpet sound; praise him with lute and harp! ⁴Praise him with tambourine and dance; praise him with strings and pipe! ⁵Praise him with sounding cymbals; praise him with loud clashing cymbals! ⁶Let everything that has breath praise the Lord! Praise the Lord!

Three Prayers of Praise

Prayer #1 – Lord, Teach Me to Praise Your Name Everywhere and in Everyway

Psalm 150:1-2 (ESV) – ¹Praise the LORD! Praise God in his sanctuary; praise him in his mighty heavens! ²Praise him for his mighty deeds; praise him according to his excellent greatness!

Prayer #2 – Lord, Teach Me to Seize the Moment that I Might Praise You With Everything I Say and Do

Psalm 150:3-5 (ESV) – ³Praise him with trumpet sound; praise him with lute and harp! ⁴Praise him with tambourine and dance; praise him with strings and pipe! ⁵Praise him with sounding cymbals; praise him with loud clashing cymbals!

Prayer #3 – Lord, Make My Life an Example of Praise Prompting Others to Honor You
