The Clash of Words: Power and Peace Proverbs 15:1-7

Series Summary

All of us have blind spots in our lives, that is, areas that we don't notice or that we tend to downplay. But these small and seemingly harmless blind spots can have disastrous results in terms of our relationship with God and with others if they go unchecked. The good news is that God, through His grace, power, and mercy, is able to open our eyes to our blind spots and equip us to renew our walk with Him in love and obedience.

Main Text

Proverbs 15:1-7(ESV) – ¹A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger. ² The tongue of the wise commends knowledge, but the mouths of fools pour out folly. ³ The eyes of the Lord are in every place, keeping watch on the evil and the good. ⁴ A gentle tongue is a tree of life, but perverseness in it breaks the spirit. ⁵ A fool despises his father's instruction, but whoever heeds reproof is prudent. ⁶ In the house of the righteous there is much treasure, but trouble befalls the income of the wicked. ⁷ The lips of the wise spread knowledge; not so the hearts of fools.

Big Idea – Be W<u>ise</u> With Your W<u>ords</u>...Honor the L<u>ord</u>, Honor O<u>thers</u>
Three Lessons Learned in Being Wise With Your Words

Lesson #1 – Foster F<u>ortitude</u>: Be P<u>atient</u> and S<u>elf</u>-C<u>ontrolled</u> With Your Words

Lesson #2 – Be Teachable: Learn from the Wise and Live a Life of Integrity

Proverbs 15:4-5(ESV) – ⁴ A gentle tongue is a tree of life, but perverseness in it breaks the spirit. ⁵ A fool despises his father's instruction, but whoever heeds reproof is prudent.

Lesson #3 – Be Steadfast: Honor the Lord in All Your Ways and Train Others With Truth

Proverbs 15:6-7(ESV) – ⁶ In the house of the righteous there is much treasure, but trouble befalls the income of the wicked. ⁷ The lips of the wise spread knowledge; not so the hearts of fools.
