### Reboot Your Pursuit: "The First S.T.E.P."

#### S – Start Your Pursuit With the Right Priorities: God and Goodness

**Romans 12:9** (ESV) – <sup>9</sup>Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good.

#### T – Think Upon These Things: Love, Kindness, and Respect

**Romans 12:10** (ESV) – <sup>10</sup>Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor.

#### E – Eagerly Serve the Lord with Passion and Persistence

**Romans 12:11** (ESV) – <sup>11</sup>Do not be slothful in zeal, be fervent in spirit, serve the Lord.

#### P – Praise the Lord with a Steadfast Pursuit of Prayer and Generosity

**Romans 12:12-13** (ESV) – <sup>12</sup>Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer. <sup>13</sup>Contribute to the needs of the saints and seek to show hospitality.
